

## 'Walls' come down at Colborne Art Gallery

COLBORNE -- New perspectives on walls will be on display at the Colborne Art Gallery's upcoming 'Wall Series'.

Guest artist Eileen Menzel's mixed media paintings will explore the significance of walls, including the defensive and protective types. The series depicts the use of metaphorical walls as various types of problem-solvers depending on the individual's political, social and personal circumstances.

Subject matter, in a variety of styles, includes such wide-ranging topics as Israeli security fences and war-time fronts to the psychological barriers of indifference and denial.

In addition to the series, new works by gallery members will be on display in the gallery's other rooms.

The Wall Series runs from Saturday, Jan. 29 to Sunday, March 6, with an opening reception on Saturday, Jan. 29 from 2 to 4 p.m. The exhibition will be open for viewing during regular gallery hours on Saturdays and Sundays from noon to 4 p.m.
